

How to build your own mirror box!



Mirror boxes can be expensive! Especially if you are recommending your patient purchase one. Online they range anywhere from \$65-\$100. Why spend so much when you can make one in under 15 minutes and under \$15.00

Supplies needed

- 1.) 1/4-Inch Pine Sanded Plywood. Have the hardware store cut to the dimensions needed. You will need 4, 1 ft x 1ft pieces. Typically, they will do the first couple of cuts for free and an additional cut or two will cost more. The sheets come in 2 ft x 2 ft; this is all you will need. This should all be less the \$10.00
- 2.) A small mirror size 7x10 inches. I called the local glass shop and the guy told me he throws away mirrors this size all the time because they are remnants from other glass projects. Purchase price.... Free!!!
- 3.) I purchased some Loctite all-purpose glue for \$3.95 at the hardware store to glue the mirror on the side of the box. Purchase price \$3.95
- 4.) 1 1/4 inch wood screws. Cost \$1.00
